- Minutes:** Acceptance of the minutes of the 16<sup>th</sup> November 2011 meeting was proposed by Peter Jerome, seconded by J Wylie, approved and signed by the Chairman.
- Matters Arising:** There were no matters arising.
- Correspondence:** Peter Jerome wrote to Fife Council to explain that the applicant Blazon Investments wanting to build 5 houses at Kinaldy Meadows has additional land at the site where he intends to build many more houses.  
Fife Council wrote to advise objectors to a Planning Application for 5 Houses to be built at Kinaldy Meadows that the applicant Mr. Kenny Simpson has gone to appeal. Scottish Ministers will review the case and the reporter will re examine the determination by Fife Council.
- Planning Matters:** We received email correspondence from a member of the public questioning the exterior finish on the houses to be built by Alan Niven next to the industrial area at Johnny Paul's Corner. We replied that he would have plenty of opportunity to object or comment when the full planning application is submitted in the future.

The Development at Feddinch was discussed following the submission of the second planning application, the first one being for the golf course itself and now for the Clubhouse and Accommodation. One of the residents at Feddinch Mr. John Wils who attended our meeting described his position as being "in touch with the Developers' and would keep CCC updated on progress.

Mr. Wils accepted to be co opted onto the Community Council, proposed by Peter Jerome and seconded by Jennifer Wylie.
