2. Community Police Team: Update

The written update from the Community Police Team (**Attachment 1**) for September 2021 was tabled and noted.

5. Planning Applications for CCC attention

a. *Matters arising from minutes of previous meeting: None*

b. 21/02819/EIA: Proposal: Extension to tourist, commercial and leisure development including 131 lodge style static caravan pitches and associated infrastructure: Land at Northbank Farm, Cameron, Lathockar, St Andrews. It was reported this application was registered on 13 October 2021, along with EIA reports. Secretary confirmed CCC had requested Statutory Consultee status.

After discussion of various issues, CCC agreed to send a list of technical/procedural queries to the Planning Case Officer, and also to consider its response as a Statutory Consultee. Deadline for making a response is 15 November 2021. CCC also agreed to highlight this application to various stakeholders.

- Denhead Road Safety, Signage. The Secretary reported L Craig had responded (after prompt from Cllr Porteous) (**Attachment 2**) that schedule for these works would be forthcoming, in time. Secretary further reported Police were interested in deploying

'Pop-up Bob' but were fully committed at present with a missing persons case in St Andrews (**Attachment 3**).

- Road to Cameron Cemetery: Cllr Holt reported no further update to her request that this road be adopted by Fife Council (**Attachment 4**).
