Bonerbo, Balmonth and Drumrack Farms went to appeal on grounds of non determination by Fife Council. Gordon attended the meeting with about 30 people to meet the Reporter who will determine whether 3 turbines 67 metres to the tip will be allowed especially as it will affect the safety of the planes using the airstrip at Kingsmuir, which is close by.
Application for a wind turbine at Beley Farm, Dunino, it is close to Dunino School and several local houses. We are going to see if there are complaints from the local residents before we comment.
There have been no changes to the way notifications of planning applications are sent to ward areas.

An update on progress tells us that there has been a delay with the bond and that it is being revised. The Council are in discussions with the developer over this issue however they have gone to appeal and the Reporter is due to visit the site on the 23rd September to review the Clubhouse and Spa application.
