

**Minutes of Cameron Community Council Meeting held in Cameron Hall on 18th
April 2012 at 6:30pm**

- Minutes:** Acceptance of the minutes of the 15th March 2012 meeting was proposed by Peter Jerome, seconded by David Brown, approved and signed by the Chairman.
- Matters Arising:** Jennifer Wylie asked about garden waste bins, Donald offered to take the matter up with Fife Council.
- Correspondence:** The results of the Poll conducted to establish the support for the proposed wind farm at Lingo were as follows: 10 for and 123 against. This makes the official submission to Fife Council from Cameron Community Council AGAINST the Lingo proposal.
- Mrs. Gillespie from Denhead brought a problem with the Fife Council Website to our attention. It is necessary to register before you can comment on a planning application. The problem lies in the software used by the Council. It asks for your postcode but when you enter the postcode the choice of addresses offered does not match the true address. The problem is further complicated by the fact you cannot make changes to the addresses offered. A letter will be sent to Fife Council asking for them to look into this matter, as this is not the first time we have come across this problem.
- We agree a letter of thanks should be published in the local newspaper and on our website.
- John Wils gave an update on the proposed Feddinch Golf course. A delay has been caused by Health and Safety issues arising with the main contractors, this now seems to be resolved. We understand the one million pound bond and land title has been cleared. The Clubhouse and Spa application has still to go before the Planning Committee.

Planning Matters: Northbank Farm have asked for an extension to their planning permission, CCC did not object to this application.

Developments: The Chairman gave a report on his presentation to the Energy Enquiry at Holyrood. Representatives from Grangemouth CC, Fintry Community Project, Ramblers Association Scotland and The Scottish Tourism Association based at Crieff.

A.O.C.B. A turbine owned by Stuart Leckie at Drumcarrow has been causing problems for Hamish Lahoar who owns the riding stables on the adjoining land. The turbines spooked horses throwing two young female riders when they rode along the private road leading up the hill to Mr. Lahoar's land.

Cllr. Donald MacGregor on behalf of the Councilors thanked CCC for their help in dealing with matters in Cameron.
Jennifer Ball asked about tree branches encroaching onto the Lathockar road, they are on Alan Niven's land so he has the responsibility for cutting or removing them it is not a Council issue.
