Correspondence:

- **Kinaldy X Roads** Continual flooding due to blocked/damaged pipe. No action from FC due to road ownership uncertainties. Also reported at the meeting was a large pothole on the Lumbo Road
- **Action:** Cllr Macgregor will contact appropriate person in Fife Council
- **Francis Melville** has agreed to attend the CCC meeting on 18th July to brief attendees on the voting systems relating to areas, wards and community councils.
- **Bowden Smith** (owner of Pittarthie farm) seeking information on progress of Lingo Farm wind turbine application and has requested attendance at CCC meeting.
- **Community Benefit group** Request from Arncroach and Carnbee Community Development Trust for CCC to join group. CCC maintain position of declining offer until clarity on development approval
- **Fife Council Building Standards and Public Safety and Development Teams** will be relocating to Glenrothes to allow majority of staff from Enterprise, Planning and Protective Services to be co-located in the same building.
- **Insurance policy** for CCC has been renewed

Planning Matters

Lingo Wind Farm Nothing further to report. Planning application will not go before planning committee until August

Website It was agreed that Cameron Community events would be displayed on the CCC website. Items would be passed to the web-site manager/ Director Robert Eadie via the Chairman. It was reported that the website has had approx... 5000 visits over an earlier three-month period.

Speakers/Members. A proposal to invite speakers on a variety of topics to CCC meetings was discussed. It was agreed that if topics were relevant to the CCC agenda this could be acceptable but overall the proposal was not supported.

Feddinch Golf Course. John Wils has received the update from the developers as follows

- Golf course contractor (SOL Construction) health and safety issues resolved. The insurers providing the £1m bond have indicated the acceptance of the substantial insurance cover held by the main contractor and the decision on their financials will be forthcoming. Once acceptance is given the construction is now expected to start approximately mid-July
- Due to some administrative issues within FC the planning application for the Club House and Spa has been delayed until August.

Fife Council Cllr Macgregor reported as follows:

- Reorganisations are taking place following the recent elections. More information will be received when finalised
- John Docherty the recently appointed SNP councillor will be attending local council meetings to introduce himself
- The locality budgets remain at between £4K and £6K although applications can be made for special projects grants.

AOCB. The Chairman announced that Inspector Bruce Thomson? will be retiring from local constabulary after 30 year's service.
