**Matters Arising:**

Drain repair at Kinaldy X roads, there has been no improvement and now there is the additional problem with flooding onto the road at the 'brick cottages'. Donald is to speak to the Council.

**Correspondence:**

We received notification that a second planning application for three wind turbines 67mtrs to the tip of the blades has been submitted for Bonerbo, Balmonth and Drumrack. This is the second application on top of the first application having gone to appeal.

**Planning Matters:**

Mt Melville planning application 12/01839/FULL erection of dwelling house in grounds to south of Mt Melville House. There were no objections from the local residents therefore a letter will be sent to fife council expressing no objections from CCC

**Lingo Wind Farm.**

We discussed the newspaper article published in The Courier written by the ACCDT making all kinds of claims that they had signed an agreement with WCE for and on behalf of local communities including Cameron. They do not have a mandate to act on behalf of members of the Cameron Community and a legal position will be sought. A follow up to this episode was Gordon and Peter having an appointment to see The Rt. Hon. Sir Ming Campbell.

John suggested we might talk to the adjoining CCs to discuss a way forward with a possible independent fund management, this is to be investigated. Peter suggested we talk to ACCDT but the conclusion was 'no change to our policy'. Gordon agreed to contact Boarhills and Dunino CC to set up a meeting.

We have not seen comments from two statutory Consultees, namely the MOD and OFCOM. We must contact Fife Council Planning to ask them to follow up on their comments.

**Feddinch Golf Course**

The Developers are to appeal against Fife Council Planning Department's non-determination of their two applications for a Clubhouse and Spar. The Company has reported that they are ready to start work on the Golf Course in the near future.

**Craigtoun Park:**

Unfortunately there is no improvement in the situation at Craigtoun, it still lacks an injection of money although there is plenty of enthusiasm from supporters.

**AOCB.** It was reported to Councilors present that the Church/Cemetery road end is braking up quite badly. Donald offered to speak to Transportation as the Council do have a responsibility to maintain roads to 'active working' Cemeteries.
