2. Community Police Team: Update

The written updates from the Community Police Team (**Attachments 1a, 1b**) for November and December 2022 were tabled and noted.

3. Approval of minutes of previous meetings

The minutes of the meeting of 16 November 2022 were approved as an accurate record.

4. Matters arising from minutes of previous meetings, not otherwise on this agenda

5. Planning Applications for CCC attention

For the record, it is noted that while Area Councillors can advise on administrative processes, they make no comment on any planning application being considered by CCC.

- a. Matters arising from minutes of previous meeting:
 - Stewart's Resort, Notice of Application for Provisional Premises Licence: Update.
 Secretary reported provisional premises licence had been granted, Dec 2022.
 Further, that the resort had been required by the Licensing Board to cease promotions for free alcohol before appropriate licences had been granted.
 - 21/02819/EIA: Extension to tourist, commercial and leisure development including 131 lodge style static caravan pitches etc, Northbank Farm. Update: Application refused, 7 Dec 2022. Fife Council's confirmation of refusal was tabled and noted (Attachment 2).
 - Development of Local Place Plans: Update: Secretary reported Fife Council had extended the deadline for submission of local place plans to end of Jan 2024. Various communications from Fife Council confirming this extension were tabled and noted (Attachments 3a, 3b, 3c). Chair circulated map of Cameron area with request for CCC to outline their initial ideas for development/non-development areas for next meeting.

Action: CCC members to indicate their ideas for development/non-development areas within Cameron area for next meeting

 22/02493/PAN: Proposal of Application Notice, 20MW solar farm with associated access and infrastructure, Winthank Farm, Denhead, Consultation event 1

- December 2022. CCC members attending noted feedback from first consultation event relating to traffic access had been considered by developers at this second consultation event.
- Fife Local Development Plan 2, online survey. CCC members confirmed link to this online survey had been circulated and also uploaded to CCC website.
- 20/02538/FULL: Stable block, Peat Inn: Update: Secretary confirmed queries re finishes etc had been forwarded to Enforcement Officer and a partial reply received. (Attachment 4).
- b. 22/04135/FULL: Change of use from former hospital to 27 flatted dwellinghouses and erection of 16 flatted dwellinghouses and 6 dwellinghouses and formation of access and hardstanding and associated landscaping (demolition of existing ancillary buildings within the curtilage) at Old Hospital Craigtoun, St Andrews and 22/04134/LBC: The related Listed Building Consent. These new applications were noted. Secretary confirmed CCC has Statutory Consultee status and until 8 February 2023 to submit a comment. Chair reported a site visit with Mt Melville residents on 16 January and Secretary confirmed an additional CCC meeting was being arranged for Wed 25 January 2023, 6.30pm in Cameron Hall, for developers to outline the proposals members of the local community may also attend. Secretary was asked to invite Area Councillors for St Andrews and East Neuk/Landward.

Action: Secretary to invite Area Councillors for St Andrews and East Neuk/Landward to additional meeting re former Craigtoun hospital building and grounds
